### WESTIN LA CANTERA RESORT

Lost Quarry pools at the Westin La Cantera Resort in San Antonio are part of the laid-back, adults-only “Time Out Experience,” which includes poolside mini massages.

**S**peaking of the Valero Texas Open, golfers who fancy themselves true competitors and would relish the chance to test themselves with a PGA TOUR-like experience can do just that during May by playing the Resort Course at the Westin La Cantera Resort.

The 7,001-yard, par 72 layout—located on one of the city’s highest points and designed by Tom Weiskopf and Jay Morrish—hosted the tournament from 1994-2009. All month, a “Play Where the Pros Played” experience will feature a round on the course, which will be specially groomed and set up to PGA TOUR specifications. Players also will be given yardage guides identical to those used by the pros during competition.

During the actual week of the Open, a special package will include a morning shotgun start, signature lunch, tickets to watch that day’s round on the AT&T Oaks course at TPC San Antonio, plus transportation to and from the event.

Another golf experience not to be missed at the Westin La Cantera Resort is the 6,926-yard Palmer Course, which opened in 2001. Combined with the Resort Course, this pairing of public-course challenges is the first in South Texas to provide 36 holes of championship golf designed by two of the game’s legends. Both courses include an enhanced range experience with attendant, relaxation center, target greens and complete short-game practice area, plus certified Titleist clubfitting services.

Built on the site of an abandoned limestone quarry, the Westin La Cantera Resort has earned the AAA 4 Diamond rating from 2000 through 2009, and it offers far more than great golf and spectacular views. After a day’s play on either—or both—courses, guests enjoy extraordinary amenities and programs that pamper.

Last year, for example, the resort celebrated its 10th anniversary by renovating all 508 guest rooms, suites and meeting spaces to the tune of \$12 million. And guests now can take advantage of the resort’s laid-back, adults-only “Time Out Experience,” which includes the following options and more:

> **Texas Wine Tasting:** Sommelier Steve Krueger demonstrates why Texas ranks among the top five wine-producing states in the U.S. In fact, Westin La Cantera sits at the gateway to more than 11 wineries and partners with several vineyards to offer special wine tastings and dinners.

> **Poolside Harmony:** Westin’s talented spa providers enhance the poolside experience with head, neck and shoulder massages.

> **La Cantera Nature Trail:** This path, new last year, wraps around the resort and allows guests to reconnect with nature, whether on a run or a simple stroll.
